Introduction

This accounting year 2016-2017 OASIS FOUNDATION has been successfully completed the following programmes with the cooperation of our board of trustees, staff team, volunteers and the general public.

BIO-DIVERSITY CONSERVATION PROGRAMME

Environmental conservation, protection and promotion interdependent on bio-diversity. Due to ecological imbalance brings climate change, global warming and all sorts of pollutions. In order to promote the ecological balance we have organized this program me the resource person narrated how to stop global warming and climate change? How to protect ecological balance? At the end of the programme we have distributed 250 multi species of tree seedlings.

TUTION CENTREPROGRAMME

On the eve of the Consultation programme leading NGOs dealing with education to tribals and people affected by certain commotions in the community. We have participated in the workshop and contributed our points like child centered learning methods suitable for typical situations and peaceful time.

MEDICINAL PLANTSPROMOTION PROGRAMME :

The programme was anchored by our Trust and other Social Activists interested in this subject. This programme was attended by many volunteers and officers of NGOs and many NGOs participated in the programme by deputing their office bearers and volunteers. . The speakers spoke on society moving at a faster and more detached manner due to technology. They said that no person detach himself from the society and suggested people should participate in more community activities such as attending community events, volunteering and organizing a neighborhood community party. These are the most common events of community relationship building efforts and people should involve in such attempts to create community relationship.

Income Generation programme:

Skills and knowledge are the engines of economic growth and social development. This programme was organized by our Trust to develop women workers into knowledge workers who will be more multi-skilled. This income generation training programme was attended by about 14 rural women. The content of the course included details of different varieties of mushrooms, like Oyster mushroom, Paddy straw mushroom, etc. and selection of suitable mushroom for cultivation and Infrastructure requirement for setting up a composite mushroom farm. All participants took interest in learning the new skills through this programme.

Personality Development Programme:

This year Youth Empowerment and Personality Development programs were combined by our Trust. Youth are powerful to create community change and with this view our Managing Trustee had invited many youth leaders to participate in the event. The guest speaker spoke on the concept and said that It was a three-pronged approach that effectively engages young people in work that challenges them to develop skills, gain critical awareness, and participate in opportunities that are necessary for creating community change. Our Managing Trustee said that the process of providing youth with platforms for decision-making and encouraging their active participation in creating community change is the crux of the issue. The participants enjoyed the discussion which is useful in developing their personality.

Vocational Training Programme

OASIS FOUNDATION selected 46 semi illiterate women and girls from 15 villages to develop their skill in the trade. The prime purpose of the training programme is to enable them to sustain regular income. The programme was conducted in its training centre with a qualified instructor. The programme was conducted in batches as a six month courses. The identifies interested 60 trained candidates found employment in primarily in tailoring units and few of established their our units.
